We are On The Verge Of A Tremendous Change

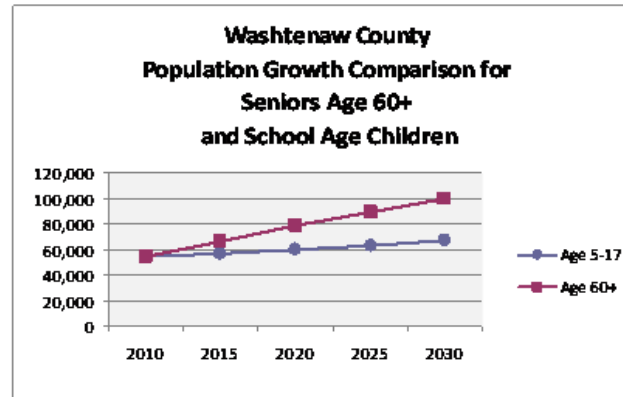


- By 2030 our population of adults over age 60 will triple in Washtenaw County.
- While current needs already far exceed current services, future needs of older adults and their caregivers will intensify dramatically, placing potentially overwhelming demands on support services and programs for seniors.

Saline is projected to have 1.5 times more older adults than school-aged children by 2030.

Housing & Home Safety



- **Housing Bureau for Seniors**

- Provides help with home repair and maintenance needs to older adult home owners, age 60-years or older.

Health



- **CSSW - Medicare Medicaid Assistance Program (MMAP)**

- Offers reviews of medical insurance coverages and prescription drug coverage (Part D) to ensure that individuals are enrolled in the best plan for them.
- Part D open enrollment is October 15th – December 7th.
- Helps older adults with lower income access programs which might reduce the cost of medical coverage.

- **Home Delivered Meals: Saline Senior Center**

- Serves residents living within the Saline School District. Cost is \$2.50 for hot lunch and .50 for a white sack supper. Each recipient receives one hot meal per day between 11:30 – 1:30, Monday through Friday, not including holidays or snow days.
